

Kayne Anderson Energy Total Return Fund Provides Unaudited Balance Sheet Information and Announces its Net Asset Value and Asset Coverage Ratios at June 30, 2018

Houston, TX – July 2, 2018 – Kayne Anderson Energy Total Return Fund, Inc. (the “Fund”) (NYSE: KYE) today provided a summary unaudited statement of assets and liabilities and announced its net asset value and asset coverage ratios under the Investment Company Act of 1940 (the “1940 Act”) as of June 30, 2018.

As of June 30, 2018, the Fund’s net assets were \$381 million, and its net asset value per share was \$10.34. As of June 30, 2018, the Fund’s asset coverage ratio under the 1940 Act with respect to senior securities representing indebtedness was 466% and the Fund’s asset coverage ratio under the 1940 Act with respect to total leverage (debt and preferred stock) was 346%.

The Fund had 36,841,723 common shares outstanding as of June 30, 2018.

As of June 30, 2018, equity and debt investments were 96% and 4%, respectively, of the Fund's long-term investments of \$534 million. Long-term investments were comprised of Midstream Company (70%), MLP (24%), Other Energy (2%) and Debt (4%).

The Fund intends to achieve this investment objective by investing in a portfolio of companies in the energy sector, principally including publicly-traded energy-related master limited partnerships and limited liability companies taxed as partnerships and their affiliates, and other companies that derive at least 50% of their revenues from operating assets used in, or providing energy-related services for, the exploration, development, production, gathering, transportation, processing, storing, refining, distribution, mining or marketing of natural gas, natural gas liquids (including propane), crude oil, refined petroleum products or coal.
