

## Kayne Anderson Midstream/Energy Fund Provides Unaudited Balance Sheet Information and Announces its Net Asset Value and Asset Coverage Ratios at February 29, 2020

Houston, TX – March 3, 2020 – Kayne Anderson Midstream/Energy Fund, Inc. (the “Fund”) (NYSE: KMF) today provided a summary unaudited statement of assets and liabilities and announced its net asset value and asset coverage ratios under the Investment Company Act of 1940 (the “1940 Act”) as of February 29, 2020.

As of February 29, 2020, the Fund’s net assets were \$471 million and its net asset value per share was \$9.97. As of February 29, 2020, the Fund’s asset coverage ratio under the 1940 Act with respect to senior securities representing indebtedness was 372% and the Fund’s asset coverage ratio under the 1940 Act with respect to total leverage (debt and preferred stock) was 271%.

The Fund had 47,197,462 common shares outstanding as of February 29, 2020.

As of February 29, 2020, equity and debt investments were 98% and 2%, respectively, of the Fund's long-term investments of \$714 million. Long-term investments were comprised of Midstream Company (56%), Midstream MLP (25%), Renewable Infrastructure/Utility Company (16%), Other Energy (1%), and Debt (2%).
