Investment Objective

To obtain a high after-tax total return by investing at least 85% of its total assets in energy-related master limited partnerships and their affiliates and in other companies that operate assets used in the gathering, transporting, processing, storing, refining, distributing, mining or marketing of natural gas, natural gas liquids, crude oil, refined petroleum products or coal.

Positioned to Capitalize on the Energy Transition

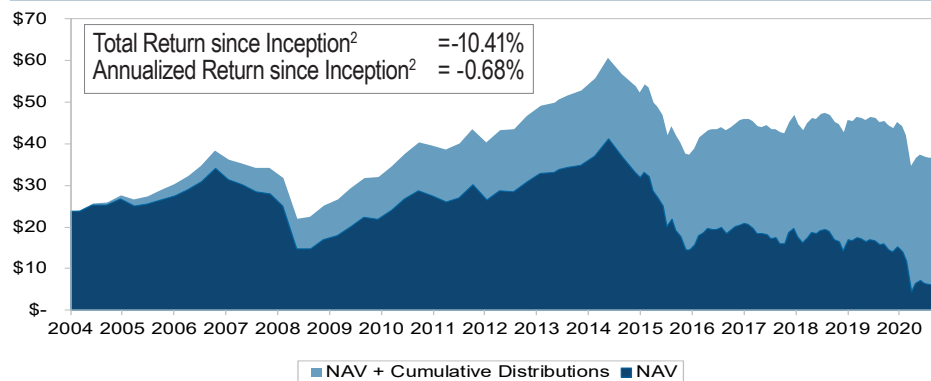

- Suitable for IRAs, foundations, and tax-exempt accounts (no UBTI)

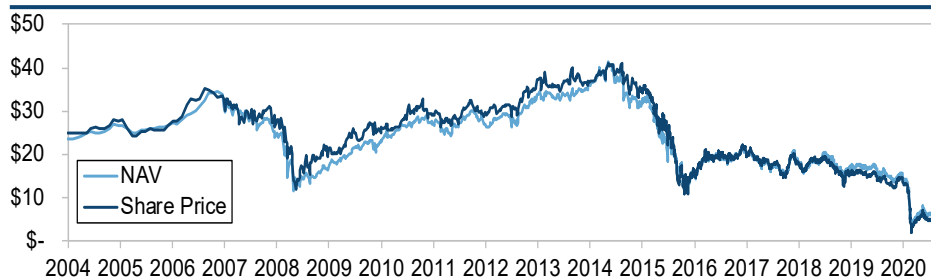
Total Return (NAV plus Distributions)

9/28/04 to 9/30/20



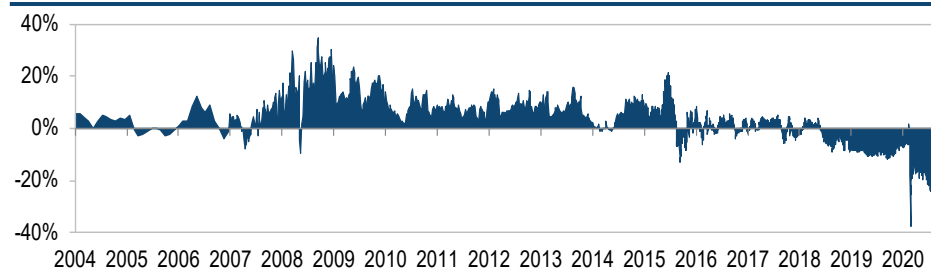
Share Price and NAV History

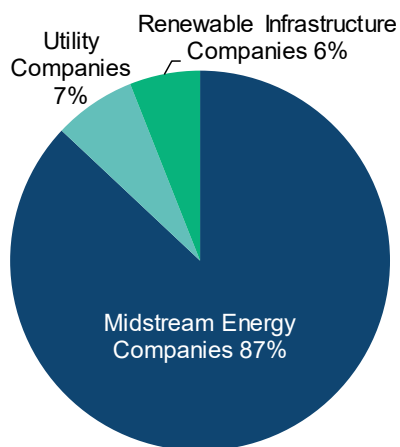

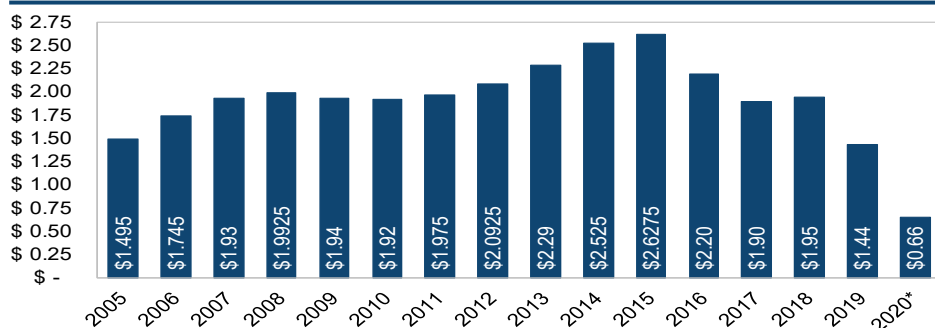

Information on Tax Character of Distributions

Our distributions are treated as a taxable dividend (qualified dividends) to our common stockholders to the extent of our current and accumulated earnings and profits. If the distribution exceeds our current or accumulated earnings and profits, the distribution will be treated as a return of capital to our common stockholders to the extent of each stockholder's basis in our common stock, and then the amount of a distribution in excess of such stockholder's basis would be taxed as capital gain. Because the cash distributions received from the MLPs in our portfolio are expected to exceed the earnings and profits associated with owning such MLPs, a portion of our distributions may be paid from sources other than our current and accumulated earnings and profits. The table above left summarizes the tax character of our distributions for the past ten years.
